## Money shock as KU students return Varsity springs up fees surprise

Students were required to clear their arrears for the 1997/98 academic year before registration, but very few managed.

Those turned away were asked to take the semester off to look for fees. Permission to be away was to be sought from the academic registrar, Prof John Shiundu.

Also not registered was the student expelled last Friday and 17 others suspended for periods ranging between one and four years for allegedly organising
