Ndingi urges Govt to give schools land

Archbishop Ndingi Mwana a'Nzeki yesterday appealed to the Government and local authorities to allocate more land for development and expansion of schools.

The Catholic Archbishop of Nairobi urged the City Council to "allocate land to the Church, and I can assure you a new school will be in place within three years".

He said the Church was "willing to start new schools and will continue to co-operate with the Government and civic authorities in developing educational institutions".

Archbishop Ndingi was addressing pupils, teachers and parents of Nairobi South B's Our Lady of Mercy Primary School, during celebrations to mark the institution's 40th anniversary.

He appealed to parents with physically-handicapped children not to neglect them. "Don't give up on them. Give them special attention, you never know what God has in store for them."

He called on parents to sacrifice to ensure their children received the best education and upbringing.
