Question 2. (20 marks) A traditional saying can help us to understand our being and acting. “Watch your thoughts because they become words; Hear your words because they become actions, Watch your actions because they become habits. Watch your habits because they become your character. Watch your character because they become your destiny.”

Explain: **(a)** the three levels of the triadic structure of the person (10 marks) and **(b)** the type of good you can do at each of the three levels with your professional work. (10 marks)
