 - ii. Economic inequality (6 marks)
 - iii. Social inequality (6 marks)
 - iv. Geographic inequality (6 marks)

QUESTION TWO: (15 MARKS)

- a) There has been unequal access to the Covid-19 vaccinations globally, between countries as well as within countries. Discuss the reasons behind this uneven vaccine distribution. (6 marks)
- b) Outline <u>three</u> impacts on development resulting from the Russian-Ukraine war. (9 marks)

QUESTION THREE: (15 MARKS)

- a) Leadership is a key factor in development. Using relevant examples, discuss the relationship between leadership and development in Africa. (6 marks)
- b) Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) 12 focuses on 'Responsible Production and Consumption.' Discuss three differences between developed and developing countries in production and consumption patterns. (9 marks)

QUESTION FOUR: (15 MARKS)

a) Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) 5 is the achievement of Gender Equality.

Outline <u>three</u> measures that the Kenyan government has taken towards this goal (9 marks)
