- 2. Identify the three main levels of analysis and examine their relevance in the study of International Relations. Use relevant examples (15 marks)
- 3. Using *dependency theory* critically evaluate the range of answers that the theory would offer to the causes of war as well as the conditions under which peace could be achieved. Cite the relevant examples (15 marks)
- **4.** Using relevant examples explain the relevance of constructivism in understanding the war and peace in International Relations (15 marks).
- 5. Focusing your analysis on Feminism on a case study you are familiar with, assess the *strengths and weaknesses* of the theory in explaining International Relations. (15 Points)
