Varsity land 'may be grabbed'

The vice chancellor of the University of Nairobi, Prof Francis Gichaga, yesterday confirmed that part of the institution's land on which the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine stands had been surveyed and could be earmarked for grabbing.

The land is situated near Ndumbuini trading centre, about two kilometres from Kabete Campus.

"You know it is commonplace nowadays for people to grab any land they come across, especially that belonging to public institutions," he said in reaction to rumours in the area that the land had been grabbed.

The VC said the title deed for the plot was being processed.
