Lecturers complain

A GROUP of foreign lecturers at Egerton University yesterday claimed that the campus administration was planning not to renew their contracts once they expire.

The lecturers from Liberia, Ethiopia, Tanzania and Uganda said the move was highly suspicious and uncalled for. They further alleged that they have not been receiving their salaries on time, which they said was meant to frustrate them. The lecturers who did not want their names disclosed, talked of a myriad problems facing the institution which include lack of drugs at the campus dispensary and congestion both in lecture halls and halls of residence.
